Pilgrimage to Poland With Deacon Anthony

Itinerary Highlights

DAY 1: Monday, March 29: Depart the USA on an overnight flight to Warsaw Poland

DAY 2: Tuesday, March 30: We arrive in Warsaw

We have **Mass** at St. James Church where St. Faustina discerned her vocation. Then we visit The Cross of Pope St. John Paul II where he said Mass during communist occupation.

Overnight in Warsaw. (D)

DAY 3: Wednesday, March 31: Warsaw

Mass at Stanislaw Kostka Church - Church of Blessed Fr. Jerzy Popieluszko who was killed as a founding member of the Solidarity Movement. Then we visit the convent of St. Faustina. Spend the afternoon touring Warsaw.

Overnight in Warsaw (B,D)

DAY 4: Thursday, April 1: Warsaw, Niepokolanow, Swinice, and Czestochowa

We leave Warsaw to head to Niepokolanow to have **Mass** at the Friary of St. Maximilian Kolbe. We then go to Swinice Warckie - St. Casimir where St. Faustina grew up. Then drive to beautiful Czestochowa for dinner and closing of the alter ceremony.

Overnight in Czestochowa, (B,D)

DAY 5: Friday, April 2: Czestochowa

We start with **Mass** and a tour at Jasna Gora Monastery where Our Lady of Czestochowa is enshrined. We can take some time for prayer and exploring the beautiful town of Czestochowa including the Holy Family Cathedral. Then we head to Krakow.

Overnight in Krakow. (B,D)

DAY 6: Saturday, April 3: Auschwitz

We depart Krakow to drive to Auschwitz. Here we will have a tour of the Nazi concentration camps including Auschwitz and Birkenau. We will have the opportunity to visit the cell where St. Maximilian died after he offered his life to save another prisoner. We will end the visit to Auschwitz with prayer and **Mass** at a local friary.

We will return to Krakow for dinner, then attend the overnight Divine Mercy Vigil (subject to confirmation)

Overnight in Krakow. (B,D)

DAY 7: Divine Mercy Sunday, April 4: Divine Mercy and Have No Fear

We spend the day at Lagiewniki (Shrine of Divine Mercy) where we will have the opportunity to go to **Mass** at the shrine, then pray and venerate one of the original images of Divine Mercy as dictated by St. Faustina. We will then go to the Have No Fear Center commemorating John Paul II.

Overnight in Krakow. (B,D)

DAY 8: Monday, April 5: Krakow

This morning we celebrate **Mass** at the Cathedral in St. Leonard's Crypt at the alter of John Paul II's first mass (subject to confirmation). Then visit the basilica of St. Francis that was erected while he was still alive. St. Maximilian spent a couple of years here and John Paul II prayed here regularly during his time as the Cardinal-Archbishop of Krakow. We then visit the offices of John Paul II and continue to explore the historic old city of Krakow. We will visit the Basilica of St. Mary, where Fr. Karol Wojtyla (JPII) was a priest and his first parish of St. Florian.

Overnight in Krakow. (B,D)

DAY 9: Tuesday, April 6: Wadowice and Kalwaria Zebrzydowska

After a good breakfast, we go to the Marian-Passion Sanctuary, Kalwaria Zebrzydowska, known as the Polish Jerusalem. The Shrine is dedicated to the Passion of the Christ and also to the miraculous Icon of the Virgin Mary. Then we drive to Wadowice, young Karol Wojtyla's childhood home. We will visit the flat he grew up in and a museum commemorating his life. We will have **Mass** at the church where he was baptized and went to as a boy, the Basilica of the Presentation of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

Overnight in Krakow. (B, Special Farewell Dinner)

DAY 10: Wednesday, April 7: (Depart for the USA)*

After breakfast, we depart for the Krakow airport for our flight back home.

DEPOSITS AND PAYMENTS: A deposit of \$500.00 per person is required to make a reservation, however, **the final payment is due on January 28, 2027**. We suggest a full payment be made by personal check or money order. Credit card payments will be accepted but will incur a 4% surcharge. Reservations received after December 28, 2026 may incur additional charges due to supplier contract terms.

CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS:

There will be no refund for cancellations for any reason after January 28, 2027. no-shows, or partially completed tours. All cancellation requests must be addressed in writing to Duc in Altum. **Trip cancellation insurance is HIGHLY recommended.** All cancellations that occur before 90 and 60 days will incur a penalty of 20% and 50%. All cancellations that occur within 60 days of departure have to be submitted through Travel Insurance. If a roommate cancels, the cost of a solo supplement will be added to your invoice unless another roommate can be secured.

FARE INCLUSIVE. Roundtrip air transportation from Washington DC (IAD) as indicated on the registration form. Ten (10) nights hotel accommodations, based on two people sharing a double or twin-bedded room in four-star hotels by (local standards). All meals as outlined in the brochure consist of full Local breakfasts (B) and dinners at the hotel (D). Sightseeing as outlined in the itinerary by private motor coaches, utilizing the services of a Government licensed, local English-speaking tour guide. Entrance fees for attractions if applicable. All transfers between airports and hotels by private motor coach. Service charges and taxes normally levied by hotels and restaurants. All U.S. & Poland departure taxes are included in the price of the tour. The brochure price is per person in US dollars.

TOUR ITINERARY SUBJECT TO CHANGE: Duc in Altum constantly strives to adhere to the specifics shown in the itinerary; however, circumstances may necessitate changes. Such circumstances may require changes without advance notice during the tour. Duc in Altum Travel reserves the right to change the itinerary if unforeseen circumstances beyond our control force a change. Duc in Altum Travel is not responsible for any changes caused by unforeseen circumstances.

TOUR CANCELLATION: Duc in Altum reserves the right to cancel or withdraw the tour at any time. In the event of a cancellation deemed necessary by Duc in Altum, the sole and exclusive responsibility of Duc in Altum is to refund all monies recovered.

NOT INCLUDED: Passport costs, visa fees (if any), and health documentation costs (when required); food and beverages (including coffee and tea) not usually included with the table d'hôte meals; optional sightseeing tours and excursions; accident and baggage insurance; transporting and handling excess luggage; tips to persons rendering special personal services; items of a purely personal nature such as laundry, telephone, and cable expenses, room service orders, etc.; transportation between the home city and the international departure city. Tips to guides, motor coach drivers, hotel porters, and restaurant staff (i.e. maître d', table waiter, etc.)

AIR ROUTINGS: The brochure price includes IATA jet economy class transportation from the international departure city applicable on all IATA and ARC carriers, based on the 6/45-day Apex fare to Poland. Duc in Altum reserves the right to choose the air carrier, routing, and departure time for each passenger. Airfares used are based on contracted group fares and are highly restrictive. Payments for and restrictions on airline tickets are governed by the applicable fare. Cancellation fees levied by the airlines are applicable if you cancel or change your air ticket for any reason after purchase of air ticket. Ticketing must be completed 45 days prior to departure. Group fares do not permit deviations; passengers who wish to deviate may arrange their own airfare. An airline credit of \$800 will be given to those passengers who arrange their own airfare. Passengers planning to arrange their own air transportation must notify Duc in Altum in writing on or before December 28, 2026. Seat numbers will be assigned by the airline at check-in; **specific seat requests cannot be processed by Duc in Altum and must be dealt with directly with the airline.** Passengers are responsible for providing frequent-flyer information upon check-in.

HOTELS: Tour prices are per person, based on two people sharing a room in Deluxe hotels. Single rooms are subject to availability and at an additional cost of \$900.00 (tour participants without a roommate will have to pay a single room surcharge).

BAGGAGE: You may check no more than one (1) piece of luggage whose overall dimensions does not exceed 62 inches (length + width + height) and whose weight does not exceed fifty (50) pounds in total. Checking a second bag will incur an additional baggage fee upon checking in with the airline. Each passenger may also bring one (1) piece of carry-on luggage. Suggested tips to hotel porters include only one normal sized piece of luggage, excluding carry-on bags which must remain in your possession at all times. These regulations may change without notice so please read the monthly correspondence you will receive from Duc in Altum for the most current information. Garment bags cannot be carried. Under no circumstances may dangerous articles such as firearms, explosives, oxygen, or combustible substances be contained in any baggage. Medications, valuables, passports, and a change of clothing should be packed in your carry-on bag.

DISABILITIES: Due to the difficult terrain at sites we visit, persons requiring oxygen or oxygen therapy will not be permitted on the tour. For reasons of passenger safety and well-being, persons with impaired mobility, vision, or mental capacity will not be permitted on the tour. Duc in Altum reserves the right to refuse passage to someone who is in such physical or mental condition as to be unfit for travel or who may require care and attention beyond that which the tour guide and tour host can provide. The tour requires a substantial amount of walking and the sites are not accessible by wheelchair. **A passenger must be able to walk at least two miles over the course of a day, up and down slopes, steps and on uneven terrain.**

All exceptions to this must be submitted in writing and must be accompanied by a qualified physically able travel companion.

INSURANCE: Acting only as agents for suppliers, Duc in Altum is not responsible for damage, loss, or theft of luggage and/or personal belongings, or for personal injury, accident, illness and/or death as a result of any occurrences or conditions beyond its control, including, but not limited to, defects in vehicles, breakdown in equipment, strikes, terrorist attacks, hostage situations, kidnappings, hijackings, protests, riots, public demonstrations, or theft. For your protection, it is important that you have adequate insurance to cover these possibilities. Additional information and application forms for all types of coverage will be supplied to you prior to departure.

PASSPORT: A valid passport, that does not expire before October 7, 2027, is required and must be obtained in person by each tour member. Complete instructions and application forms for passports can be obtained by contacting your local courthouse or post office.
